Grand Marshal, Frank Camillieri didn't start riding a motorcycle until his 20's, and began his racing career in 1965. He quickly moved up the grid, winning multiple class champions with aamr (American Association of Motorcycle Road Racers) and the AMA (American Motorcyclist Association).

By the late 60's, Frank was sponsored by Boston Cycle and became a nationally-ranked AMA rider. His on-track accomplishments include consistent top ten finishes battling (and often besting) the likes of Phil Read, Bill Ivy, and Yvon DuHamel. He finished 5th in the 1967 FIM Grand Prix at Mosport in the 250cc class aboard his TD-K 250.

Frank retired from racing in the early 1970's to run his machining business and raise a family. He returned to racing 25 years later, with the US CRA, he picked up where he left off, becoming a perennial race winner and class champion.
